REQUIREMENTS

- Main applicant must be of 18 years of age and above.
- Have no criminal record
- Be in good health
- Meet the application requirements
- Has enough funds to make the required investment (the source of these funds must be legal)



REASONS OF REJECTION

- When providing a false information;
- If a medical practitioner states that any of the family members is suffering from a contagious disease and/or serious health problems;
- Not having received a free pardon, has at any time previously been convicted in any country of an offence for which the maximum custodial penalty is in excess of six month imprisonment;
- Is the subject of a criminal investigation;
- Is a potential national security risk to the country;
- Is involved in any activity likely to cause disrepute the country;
- Has been denied a visa to a country with which the country has visa-free travel and who has not subsequently obtained a visa to the country that issued the denial

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DOCUMENT CHECKLIST

Passports	Passports Certified copies of all passports or travel documents for all applicants
Identity Cards and/or Residence Permits	Certified copies for all applicants (if applicable)
Colored photos approximately 35x45mm	Taken on a white background on non-glossy paper for all applicants, photos must have been taken within six (6) months of the application
Birth certificates	Certified copies for all applicants
Education certificates	Certified copies for all applicants (if applicable)
Driving license	Certified copies for all applicants (if applicable). Original
Police certificates / Certificates of Count	For all applicants aged 16 (mostly) and over from any country...
Military records	Certified copies for all applicants (if applicable)
Medical certificates	Original for all applicants
Medical HIV (AIDS) test results	Original for all applicants for Caribbean programmes Must be no older than 3 months

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DOCUMENT CHECKLIST

Bank Statements	Original for main applicant only
Documents of Evidence of Residential Address	Original or certified copies for main applicant only. Not older than 3 months
Marriage Certificates	Certified copies for main applicant only (if applicable)
Divorce Documents)	Certified copies for main applicant only (if applicable)
Change of Name Documents	Certified copies for all applicants only (if applicable)

POINTS TO PONDER

- 1) The list of documents is exclusive of all application forms required for the program The list is not exhaustive and in some particular occasions, additional documents can be requested (company incorporation and good standing documents, ownership or title documents in support of SOF explanations, or any other type of document in support of the applicant's statements made on the application forms).
- 2) Any document(s) that are not in English (including certifications or stamps) must be accompanied by an authenticated translation into English. Translations must be authenticated by an Apostille according to the Hague Convention of 5 October 1961, Abolishing the Requirement of Legalisation for Foreign Public Documents
