CITIZENSHIP BY INVESTMENT PROGRAM

The Government of the Commonwealth of Dominica established the Dominica Citizenship by Investment Program in 1993, which under certain conditions allowed overseas investors to become citizens. Currently, this is among the most recognised and long-running economic citizenship programmes in existence. Those who apply are given permanent citizenship and a passport without having to live there or give up their current nationality.

ABOUT DOMINICA

The Commonwealth of Dominica is a popular ecotourism destination because of its natural surroundings, including its lush mountainous forest, natural hot springs, and diving places. It is known as the "Nature Isle of the Caribbean."

Since gaining its independence in 1979, the nation has been a part of the Organization of American States (OAS), CARICOM, the British Commonwealth, and numerous other international organisations.

Dominica has the lowest crime rate in the area and is a politically and economically stable country. Dominica also acknowledges dual citizenship.





CRIMINAL LAW

The Dominican Republic's constitution and laws—specifically, Section 101 of the Constitution, Section 8 of the Citizenship Act, Chapter 1:10 of the Revised Laws, and Section 20 (1) of the Citizenship Act 1991—define the Commonwealth of Dominica Citizenship by Investment programme.

In the Caribbean, there is duty-free trading with no limitations on the repatriation of earnings and imported capital. generous incentive programmes, including business tax breaks, complete import duty exemption, tax relief advantages, and export subsidies.

Due Dilligence

Background checks that are required must be paid for by the government, which designates a preferred due diligence organisation. These organisations consult a range of national and local resources, including Interpol, World-Check, and other governmental organisations. These feesmust be paid at the time the application is submitted.

The only additional expenditures are those for CTrustGlobal's professional services, official application forms, citizenship and passport certification, courier, and other outlays. For the particular scenario, a thorough quote that contains no additional fees is given.

Documents Required:

Documents required from each applicant (Including children):

- D2 Fingerprint and Photograph Verification Form (to be completed in front of a fingerprinting officer)
- D3 Medical Questionnaire and Certificate (to be completed by a licensed medical practitioner)
- Application Form 12 (two (2) completed and notarized copies)
- Oath of Allegiance Form
- Certified copy of all passports held
- Original excerpt of full birth record or certified copy of full birth certificate with MOFA attestation (i.e. a birth document that also includes your parent's details, or a household register, family book etc.).
- Original Police Record from country of birth, country of citizenship, country of residence (if different), and any country in which the applicant has resided for more than six (6) months in the past ten (10) years, for each applicant sixteen (16) years and over. For children aged twelve to fifteen (12-15), a sworn affidavit by the parent that a child does not have criminal record is required
- Certified copy of driver's license
- Certified copy of all identity documents/books or cards
- Certified copy of all military service and discharge documents, if applicable (male applicant 18 years and above)
- Twelve (12) Original passport-size photos
 Proof of residential address (certified copy of lease agreement or original utility bill)
- Certified copy of university/college diplomas Notarized affidavit of support for each dependent aged 18 or over included in the application, with the exception of the spouse
- Original HIV test results (for all applicants aged 12 or above)
- Original Routine blood and urine test results

Forms and documents required only from the main applicant:

- Sales and Purchase Agreement (real estate option only)
- D4 Investment Agreement (EDF option only)
- One original bank reference letter issued by an internationally recognized bank, not older than 6 months.
 Original 12 months bank statements
- One original professional reference (e.g. from an attorney, notary public, chartered accountant or other professional of similar standing), not older than 6 months.
- One original Employment letter
 Detailed business background reports/resume/CV
- Original excerpt of marriage record or certified copy of marriage certificate(s) (if applicable).
 Certified copy of divorce document(s) (if applicable)

Timeline to Citizenship:

It generally takes up to 4 months for the entire process to materialize

Step 1 (1-2 Months)

Your passport will be pre-screened by us for government pre-approval. To begin your application, a professional fee down payment is required. The skilled staff at CTrustGlobal will help and counsel you as you gather the paperwork that the government requires. Government processing fees, due diligence, and our submission invoice are due after the file is prepared for submission. Your application is sent by our agents.

Step 2 (2 - 3 Months)

A report on due diligence is given to the government. The Government decides whether to grant your request for citizenship in light of the findings. Once accepted, you are requested to make an investment or donation.

Step 3 (3-4 Months)

Passports and citizenship certificates are issued. The remaining professional charge for our services has been paid.
